*I acknowledge that the technician, Nettie Cumpton, has explained to me that Permanent Cosmetics is the same as Tattooing, therefore, the facial area will be cosmetically tattooed. Color will be implanted into the skin and as a result, the skin color will be permanently altered.

I have been informed that there will some pain involved in the procedure. I have been informed that there may be adverse effects such as swelling, bruising (extremely rare), temp. minor bleeding, redness, or pinkness and soreness. * I have been informed that Permanent Cosmetic color **WILL FADE** after application. The lighter the color chosen, the sooner it will fade. Nettie has made no guarantees or promises to me, as to how much color will be retained. Only the finest and most costly pigments and Topicals available, as well as the most advanced machine on the market are used on you. **You will receive one touchup one month after your initial appt. and no longer than 6 weeks.** This is included in your original price .At this time,we can see how well your skin took the pigment and do any "fine tuning" such as thicker or darker. **Please remember that the amount of pigment you retain or lose after your initial application is not a reflection of the quality of Nettie's work, but rather of your individual**

chemical and genetic makeup, over which we have no control. (such as, your skins moisture or lack of it, differences in skin thickness and fatty content of the underlying tissue , etc) * I have been informed that any appt. after **the second free appt.** there will be a \$100.00 charge which covers only our cost of supplies. If you are choosing the NEW Micro Stroke Brows you need to know they **WILL** require yearly maintenance due to the fact they are so delicate and placed one hair at a time. * I have been informed that pigment used in these procedures may migrate or spread to an undesired area (although rare).

* I have been informed that a secondary infection, although rare, may occur and that Nettie has gone over the entire procedure with me, noting the safeguards she has taken to prevent this while I am in her office, **(Such as barrier film on everything she touches, new pre-packaged needles, everything disposable that she uses only once.** * I have been informed of the aftercare instructions that I must follow when I leave her office to **prevent** a secondary infection from happening. Therefore releasing her from any medical obligations that I may encounter after I leave her office. *I have been informed that an allergic reaction may occur (although rare) from the pigment used in the procedure, and that a Patch Test is available on request. * I have been informed that fever blisters or cold sores may occur after a Lip procedure and that Zovirex or Valtrex (prescription) should be taken at least 4-5 days before apt. as well as 4-5 days after. If you have **NEVER** had a cold sore, Nettie recommends you take Lysine capsules (over the counter) to try and prevent you getting a cold sore after your lip procedure. * I have been informed not to take any aspirin products or ibuprofen before the procedure, as Well as no alcohol the night before procedure, as it may promote bleeding, therefore causing the color not to take. * I have been asked to inform Nettie of any facial chemical peel, abrasion, or plastic surgery which has been performed in the past 6 months, or that is scheduled in the near future. * **I have been informed to use sunscreen on a daily basis because constant exposure to the procedure will fade the color or even cause irritation to the skin.** * I have been informed that using a tanning bed will have the same results, and I must cover my brows-lips when tanning. * I have been informed that any method used to effectively remove the Permanent Cosmetics may result in scarring and / or permanent disfigurement of the face, and I assume this responsibility at my cost. * I have been informed that "before and after" photos will be taken of me, and I do agree that Nettie may use such photographs in advertising and / or in her teaching sessions. **Nettie's committed to you, her client, to keep up on everything NEW and upcoming in the PC world by attending many "Master" classes that are offered.
